Discussion Questions

1. Exodus 1:1 begins with, “These are the names of the sons of Israel...” Who is Israel?
2. How does God’s promise to Abraham (Genesis 12:2, 13:16, 15:5) relate to Exodus 1:7?
3. What motivated the king of Egypt to order the enslavement of the Israelites?
4. Why do you think the king of Egypt targeted boys – and only boys – born to Israelite women?
5. What was the gender of those who acted to preserve the life of Moses? Why might this be important?
6. The word translated “basket” in Exodus 2:3 is the same word used to describe Noah’s Ark in Genesis 6:14. How are these two “baskets” similar?
7. How do you think Pharaoh’s daughter know the baby she found was a Hebrew child?
8. How did the baby’s sister arrange for him to grow up in the Hebrew tradition and faith?
9. How do you think the baby’s mother felt when ...
 - a. She found out she had given birth to a boy?

b. When she cast her baby on the Nile?

c. When Pharaoh's daughter offered her a job?

10. Name one similarity between Exodus 2:16-21 and Genesis 29:1-14.
