Discussion Questions

1. The Ten Commandments can be divided into commandments that govern the relationship between a person/people and God and the relationships people have with one another. Which commandments do you think belong in each category?
2. Order the Ten Commandments from the one you think is most important to the one you think is least important. Be prepared to discuss!! 😊
3. Which of the Ten Commandments received the most explanation/description? Which received the least? Why do you think some of the commandments received more explanation/description than others?
4. What do you think it means to “make wrongful use of the name of the LORD”?
5. What do you think it means to bear false witness?
6. According to Moses, the LORD tested the Israelites and put the fear of God upon them so they wouldn’t sin. Do you think that the Lord uses those methods? What motivates you not to sin?

7. Why do you think the Israelites were told to use an altar made of earth or, if made of stone, that it should be of unhewn stone?

8. Chapter 21 begins a list of laws that are only applicable in certain situations, "If this, then that..." Which of these laws (in chapters 21 and 22) do you find the most surprising?

9. Read Exodus 22:2, why do you think bloodguilt would be incurred only after sunrise?

10. Why do you think God commanded that firstborn sons and livestock be given to the LORD? Why not the last born?
