Discussion Questions

1. How do you define ritual? Name one religious ritual. Name one ritual of the secular (non-religious) world.
2. The first three chapters of Leviticus outline “voluntary” offerings/sacrifices. What are these three offerings/sacrifices?
3. Is there a “value” difference between a monetary offering and the kind of offerings/sacrifices in the first three chapters of Leviticus? If so, what is the difference? If not, how are they the same?
4. Why do you think there are three types of burnt offerings?
5. What is one of the reasons a person would make a burnt offering?
6. Of the grain offerings, the ritual procedure includes the following steps: preparation, presentation, and burning (turning into smoke). Who is responsible for each step?
7. What two ingredients were to be added to grain offerings?
8. What is the most holy part of the grain offerings? What is done with it?

9. What is one difference between burnt offerings and offerings of well-being?

10. What do you think happened to what was left over from the offerings of well-being?
