Discussion Questions

1. What is done with the parts of a sacrifice of well-being (or “peace” offerings, New Living Translation; or “fellowship” offerings, Good News Translation and New International Version)? See Leviticus 3:1-17, 7:15-18, 7:28-36.

2. Why is “eating blood” prohibited?

3. Leviticus 18:1-18 describes all the prohibitions regarding sexual relations between family members. Why do you think so much attention was given to this issue?

4. In Chapter 18, what reason did the Lord give for displacing the previous inhabitants of the land in which the Israelites would settle?

5. Describe how farmers were to harvest their fields and vineyards. What was the purpose of this practice? What does this tell you about God?

6. List two scripture passages from this week’s reading that remind you of Jesus’ teachings (bonus points for gospel references!!).

7. Why do you think witchcraft and consulting mediums or wizards was forbidden?

8. Are there any prohibitions in Chapter 19 that you don't consider applicable today? Why or why not?

9. Which of Aaron's offspring through the generations could not serve as a priest? What do you think the reasoning was behind this? Name one thing you think should prevent a person from becoming a priest, minister, or pastor.
