Reading: Leviticus Chapters 4-7

Discussion Questions

1. In Chapter 4, four different types of people must make offerings to the Lord for unintentionally doing something. Who are those four types of people? What is the thing they have done?
2. In Chapter 4 verses, 14, 23, and 28, three of the types of people above have their sin “made known to them” (also translated as “sin becomes known” or “when they realize their guilt”). Which type of person doesn’t have this happen before he made a sin offering to the Lord? Why do you think this is the case?
3. Name one way the sin of a minister could “bring guilt” upon his/her congregation.
4. The offerings described in Leviticus 4:1 – 5:13 can be referred to a “purification” offerings. What do you think was purified with these offerings?
5. Leviticus 5:1-4 lists behaviors that will make a person guilty. How do these sins differ from the one referred to in Chapter 4? Why do you think the sins listed in 5:1-4 have to be confessed, while the one in Chapter 4 does not?
6. Do you think a person is guilty of sin if s/he doesn’t know s/he did something wrong? For example, is a person who got amnesia after committing a sin guilty of that sin? Why or why not?

7. Leviticus 5:14 – 6:7 refer to “guilt offerings” (also translated as “repayment offerings” or “reparation offerings”). How do these offerings differ from the ones described in Leviticus 4:1 – 5:13?

8. What is the penalty for touching any unclean thing and then eating the meat of an offering to the Lord? Why do you think this was such a serious offense?
