Discussion Questions

1. According to Number 5:1-4, what was to happen to people who had a skin disease, had a discharge, or had touched a corpse? Name two differences between this and the instructions in Leviticus 13:1-46, Leviticus 15:1-33, and Leviticus 11:24-40.
2. Under what circumstances do you think restitution would have to be paid to the injured party's next of kin (as opposed to the injured party him/herself)?
3. What two occurrences are grounds for a husband making a jealousy offering ("offering from a suspicious husband" – Good News Version)?
4. What would be the outcome of an adulterous woman drinking the water of bitterness? How might this outcome relate to her adultery?
5. How do you think a woman accused of adultery – but innocent of it – would be affected by the ordeal of Numbers 5:16-28?
6. Give a modern example of how a falsely-accused person would be affected even once he/she was acquitted.

7. What was to be the consequence for the husband who falsely accused his wife?

8. What three things were people who took Nazirite vows supposed to do (or not do)? Why do you think each of those things was important/significant? (There are no wrong answers!!!)

9. What would happen to the time a Nazirite had already dedicated to God if he/she was exposed to a corpse before his/her time of dedication had been completed?

10. If you know of one, give an example of something happening that seemed to nullify the past efforts of a faithful person.
