Attending things that happen before worship starts became impossible to manage without help – and so, we hired help! We now have someone available to care for children before worship begins so their parents can attend Sunday school. Olivia is on standby right now waiting for my husband and me to get our next foster placement, but she might also be waiting for you and your children. Sunday school starts at 9:15 a.m. I hope to see you there!
